



HOME SWEET 2023 HOUSE RULES

Thank you for participating in Home Sweet 2023. Please find information about the event below. We ask that you read and abide by the following House Rules.

When: Friday 17 March 2023. Event runs from 6pm on Friday 17 March to 8am on Saturday 18 March 2023.

Where: Freshwater Surf Life Saving Club, Freshwater NSW 2096. The entrance is on the northern side of the building.

Parking: Parking is available in the council car park next to the Surf Club. Parking is free with a permit that you can collect on arrival from the registration desk.

Parking without a permit is paid until 7pm and you need to pay again from 7am on Saturday morning. Street parking near the club is free.

What to bring

- A sleeping bag / sleeping mat /inflatable mattress /blankets / pillow. The venue has hard wooden floor.
- Headphones, eye masks, bedtime reading book, cards, other entertainment
- A torch (or use the one on your phone).
- Towel, toothbrush, toothpaste if you would like
- Power banks and charging cables

Lights out

Lights will be put out at 11pm. After this time, it is recommended to use earphones to listen to music, talk with your colleague in a low voice or use a small reading light to avoid disturbing your fellow colleagues who will be settling down to catch a few winks.

Dress code

- Smart casual
- Appropriate sleepwear, PJs

Drugs and alcohol

We remind you that the use of illegal drugs is prohibited at all times during the event. Excessive consumption of alcohol is also prohibited. Link Wentworth reserves the right to require the venue to refuse service of alcohol to any member of staff who is, in Link Wentworth's view, behaving inappropriately.

Food and drinks will be provided at the event, including alcoholic beverages. If you choose to drink alcohol, please ensure that you drink responsibly, be respectful to others and have plenty to eat.

If you are thinking about having a drink or two, we ask you that you plan your transport home (if you will not be sleeping over):

- Share a taxi with friends
- Catch public transport
- Ride with a driver that hasn't been drinking
- Arrange for a friend or relative to give you a lift

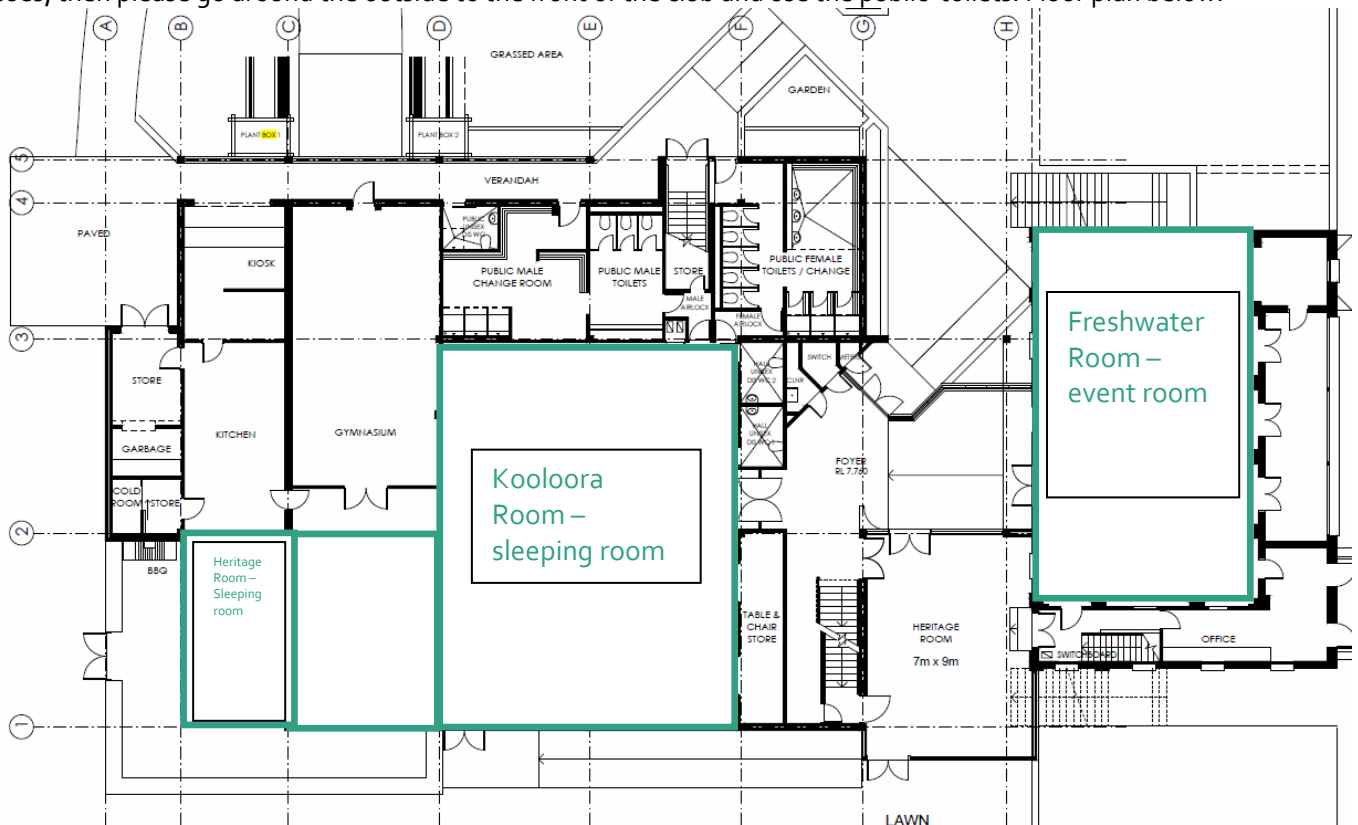


WHS to keep in mind:

- Do not bring valuables with you. Link Wentworth will not be responsible for safeguarding of valuables.
- There are two rooms as the designated areas for sleeping indoors which. These will be marked on the doors to the rooms.
- You may sleep outdoors if you wish to, however you need to be responsible for your own safety.
- Do take a look at the evacuation plan and familiarize yourself with the location of the emergency exits.
- There is a first aid kit available on site.
- Report any concerns to WHS committee member, Akanksha Agrawal - Mobile: 0400459212
- There will be security available onsite throughout the night.
- All sleepers will be given a wristband to wear until you leave the site on Saturday by 8am. Please keep this wristband on so that you can be identified by security and the cafe staff for breakfast as a Home Sweet participant.

Facilities:

Toilets – there are two toilets in the large hall (Kooloora Room). These are available all the time. If you find there are queues, then please go around the outside to the front of the club and use the public toilets. Floor plan below.



The public toilets are Council owned and operated. At 9pm the Council locks them to the public. At this time the two internal doors near the inside two toilets are opened and the public toilets can be accessed from inside the venue. If you find one of the two toilets locked, then it usually is a simple matter that a guest has locked it on their way out and a coin will simply unlock it. Venue Rules

Please also read the following rules that are set by the venue

- Absolutely NO glitter, confetti or petals to be scattered. Candles to be battery operated only
- Club equipment or display items in the Heritage room is not to be touched/played on
- No animals on the premises
- No one is to go upstairs or downstairs or into the kitchen. These areas are out of bounds
- Freshwater Surf Life Saving Club is a non-smoking venue – including all balconies and the entrance area outside the Freshwater room. Smoking is outside away from the building
- All drinking of alcohol is to be done inside the building. Alcohol is not to be taken out to the entrance area outside the Freshwater room
- Please do not go for a swim in the night.
- Children under 12 are NOT allowed
- 12 years and over children MUST be always accompanied and under the supervision of a responsible parent/guardian
